

Handling a death away from home requires coordination and cooperation between different parties, but the professionals at James H. Cole will help you navigate through the process, and ensure that your loved one's remains are handled with dignity and respect.

Immediate Response: If you are present at the time of death, call emergency services or the local authorities in the area where the death has occurred. They will respond to the scene, provide direction as to the next steps that need to be taken.

Selecting a Funeral Home: Before contacting a funeral home you will need to decide if any type of viewing or service will be held in the city where the passing has occurred. If yes, then you will need to contact a local funeral home to begin the arrangement process. Once you meet with the funeral home, you will need to provide them with the name and phone number of the funeral provider you would like your loved one shipped to for the final services and disposition to be arranged with. If you are not going to have a service in the city where the passing has occurred, then you can contact James H. Cole directly once directed by local authorities to do so. We will then handle the coordination with a local funeral home in the vicinity where the passing has occurred, and begin to arrange the transport of your loved one back home. Depending on the distance and logistics, this may involve air and/or ground transportation. James H. Cole will handle obtaining the necessary permits, and negotiate the many complexities that can arise during this process. Once your loved one is in our care, an arrangement time will be set for the family to meet with a director to make all selections and finalize the funeral service.

At James H. Cole Home for Funerals, we offer an extensive pre-planning program. We offer individuals the opportunity to plan, document, and pre-pay for their funeral arrangements in advance. Some of the key components and benefits of these services are:

Consultation and Guidance: A pre-planning counselor will meet with you to discuss your wishes and preferences detailing the type of Celebration of Life service desired. This includes disposition preferences of burial, entombment, or cremation, location of service, and other personalization options.

We will also assist you in compiling all of the required information that will be needed for the death certificate.

GENERAL PRICE LIST

The following prices are effective as of September 01, 2023, but may be subject to change without notice.

In compliance with the trade regulations of the Federal Trade Commission, we are required to provide this General Price list for retention. The goods and services shown on the following pages are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire, however, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing (on the statement we provide) describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF - \$2,200.00

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to the following: staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of notices, authorizations and consents; coordination with those providing other portion of the funeral. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance and utility expenses, secretarial and administrative costs, and equipment and inventory expense.

This fee is for our basic services. Overhead will be added to the cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving of remains.)

TRANSFER OF REMAINS TO THE FUNERAL HOME

Within a radius 30 miles \$250.00

The charge for additional mileage is \$3.00 per mile

EMBALMING - \$825.00

Except in certain special cases (see requirements of Michigan law stated below), embalming is not required by law. However, embalming may be necessary if you select certain funeral arrangements such as a funeral with viewing or visitation. Most common carriers also require embalming. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. *Note:* Michigan law requires embalming when death was caused by certain infectious diseases, or with limited exceptions, including when a body is not taken to the location of final disposition (such as a cemetery or crematory) within 48 (forty-eight) hours of the time of death.

It does not include the staff or the use facilities for any viewing, visitation, wake, family hour, rites or ceremonies prior to forwarding the remains, or common carrier charges.

Fee. This charge includes receiving the remains from another funeral home, temporary shelter of remains, obtaining necessary authorizations, local (within 30 miles) transportation of remains to cemetery or crematory, and basic services of funeral director and staff. It does not include the service of staff or the use of facilities for any viewing, visitation, wake, family hour, rites or ceremonies after receiving the remains, common carrier charges, or transporting the remains from the airport or other transport destination. The cost of transportation beyond a radius of 30 miles in funeral home vehicles is \$3.00 per mile.

Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). Our charges do not include the use of the facilities or staff for any viewing, visitation or ceremony (public or private), the actual cost of cremation process, or any other goods or services except where expressly stated.
